




Exterior Front View

The United States Marshals Museum (USMM) is a 53,000-square-foot, world-class facility on the bank of the Arkansas River in Fort Smith, Ark. The USMM will be iconic in design and transformative in experience.

The USMM will feature a National Learning Center (NLC), which will combine the USMM experience with the challenge of teaching civic literacy and discourse, engaging local and national audiences using a variety of resources. The NLC will utilize technology in its distance-learning programming, making its curricula available nationwide.

The USMM will feature an experience more than just objects in cases and text panels. The experience will be interactive, moving, and impactful, grounded in story and emotion. The USMM will use a story-driven approach, creating a state-of-the-art experience that will engage guests in immersive environments, up-to-date technology, larger-than-life imagery, and objects displayed in meaningful ways.
