\$500,000 Matching Donation Given to the United States Marshals Museum Museum Only \$100,000 Away from Match!

FORT SMITH, Ark. (September 27, 2020) – The United States Marshals Museum (USMM) announced today that they received a \$500,000 matching donation in April of this year. With already \$400,000 raised towards the match, the Museum is looking to close the gap on the remaining \$100,000.

The United States Marshals Museum has \$13 million left to raise in the current capital campaign, with focus on \$8 million of that, which will allow the experience inside the Museum to be produced. The impressive 53,000 square foot building that rises like America’s star on the bank of Arkansas in Fort Smith was finished in the fall of 2019.
